- An annual ranking of countries by Charities Aid Foundation (CAF) in the UK based on a survey that asks the following:

Have you done any of the following in the past month?

- 1) *Helped a stranger, or someone you didn't know who needed help?*
- 2) *Donated money to a charity*
- 3) *Volunteered your time to an organization?*

- Korea ranks 57th among 126 countries on a 10 year aggregate ranking.

Doing Good Index

Doing Good Index: four clusters⁺



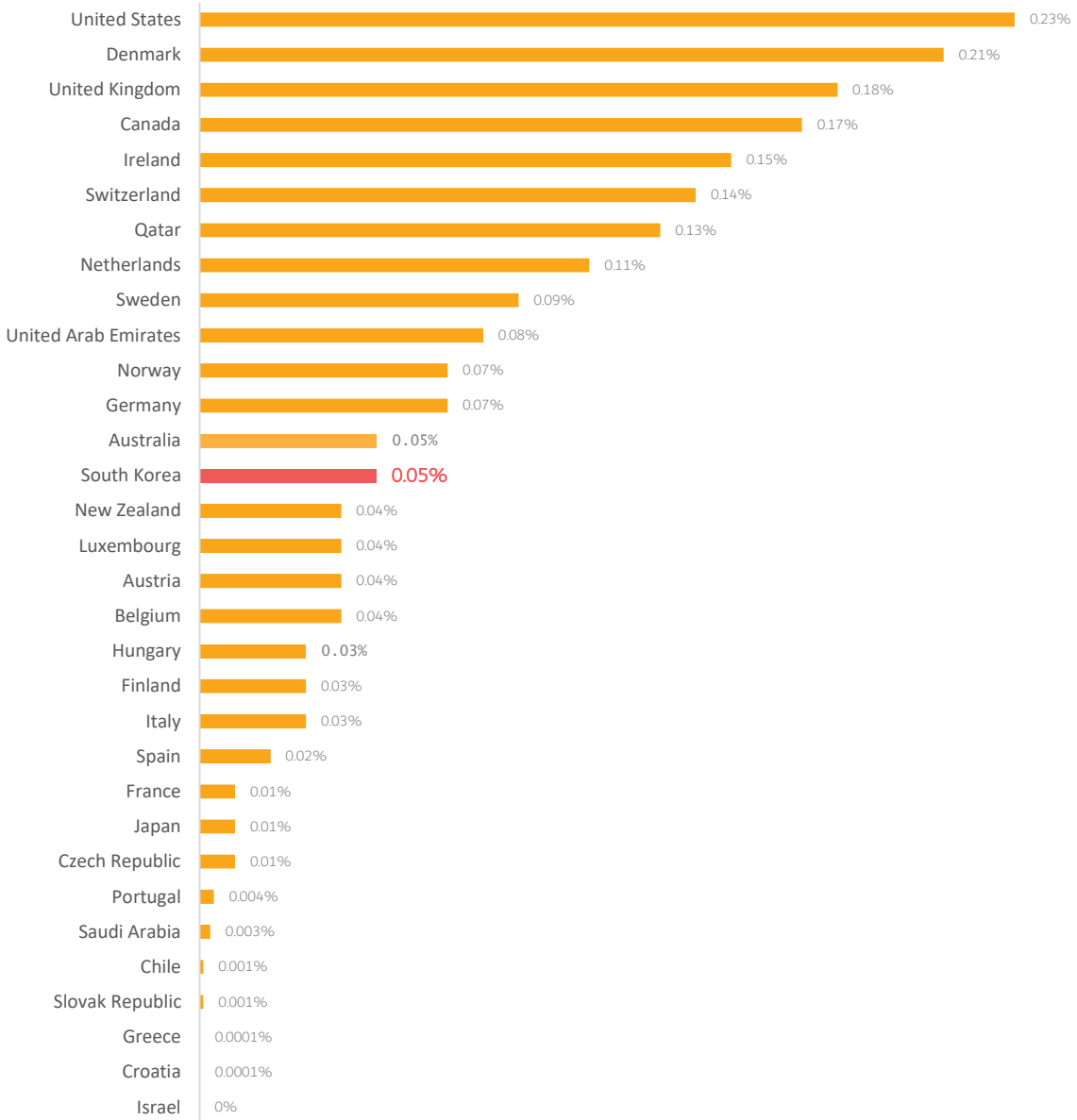

- The Doing Good Index by the Centre for Asian Philanthropy and Society (CAPS) in Hong Kong surveys 18 Asian economies on 4 areas: Regulations, Tax and Fiscal, Ecosystem, Procurement. Based on the survey results, the economies are grouped into 4 clusters: Doing Well, Doing Better, Doing Okay, Not Doing Enough.
- Korea has been in the ‘Doing Better’ cluster for both 2018 and 2020.

- Research by Indiana University Lilly Family School of Philanthropy on the global flow of donations. It studied the amount of foreign aid spent by countries.
- Korea ranked 14th among 32 countries for foreign aid compared to Gross National Income (GNI).
